### 2018 Mid-Term Exam Reminders

- HS Students are not required to be in school if they do not have an exam.
- MS Students are required to be in school for their entire half day schedule each day.
- HS Students may arrive for the start of their exam assuming they have a ride.
- Buses will run on their regular morning schedule. If a student needs to take the bus, there are two study areas available for them to study while waiting for their exam.
- Media Center Study Area is a QUIET exam prep area. Cafeteria Study Area is for study groups working together to study.
- Students are to adhere to the exam schedule. All requests for alternative exam times must be approved by administration on or before January 19<sup>th</sup>
- *15 Minute Rule:* Students can enter the exam room up to 15 minutes after the exam begins. 16 minutes plus must have teacher's permission. If a student is tardy, no additional time will be provided for completion of the exam.
- **Students must remain in the exam rooms for the full exam period.** Bathroom breaks are at the teacher's discretion.
- Students' cell phones must be turned off, in their bags/backpacks or placed in a common locations designated by the teacher.
- If a student is unable to attend an exam due to extenuating circumstances, including illness, a parent must call and request permission from the administration ([stgermaink@northstonyington.k12.ct.us](mailto:stgermaink@northstonyington.k12.ct.us) / 860-535-0377 ext. 301)
  - The student must also communicate with teacher via email to arrange a make-up exam during the make-up exam slot.
