Welcome. This is a list of requirements that you can refer to throughout the school year.

- 1) **TESTS & QUIZZES** - There will be quizzes given within each chapter worth 25 points each. There will be a test given after each chapter worth a total of 100 points. There are no retakes or tests dropped. If a student is absent they will take the test or quiz the following day.
- 2) **HOMEWORK**- Homework will be assigned on a weekly basis. Homework will be collected and graded at the end of each week. This will be worth 10 points for each assignment. Late assignments will lose points.
- 3) **NOTEBOOK** - All students are required to bring a 3-ring binder filled with 8 ½ x 11 inch paper and graph paper. Notebooks must have three sections in it (class notes, homework, and tests/quizzes) with dividers. Having an organized notebook will be worth 25 points at the end of each quarter.
- 4) **TEXTBOOK** - All students are expected to bring a notebook, textbook, calculator pencil and eraser every day to class. All textbooks must be covered.
- 5) **QUARTER GRADES** - Your grade after each quarter will be calculated based on the total points of your tests, quizzes, notebook and homework grades.
- 6) **SEMESTER & FINAL GRADES** – Your semester grade is based on each quarter (40% each) and your midterm exam (20%). Your final grade is calculated by taking 50% of each semester grade.
- 7) **CALCULATORS** - All students are strongly recommended to have a TI-83, TI-84, TI-84C or better graphic calculator. If a student cannot afford a graphing calculator, the school will provide them with one.
- 8) **TEACHER AVAILABILITY FOR EXTRA HELP** - I will be available after school every day Monday thru Friday until 2:35. Also, I will be available every day during break and during period 7 in the library.
- 9) **CELL PHONES** - Students are not allowed to use cell phones during class. Any student caught using a cell phone will be required to leave it on the teacher's desk for the duration of the period.
