*Welcome. This is a list of requirements that you can refer to throughout the year to make your senior year of high school math class a success.*

- 1) TESTS & QUIZZES- There will be a test given after each chapter worth a total of 100 points. There will be 2-3 quizzes given every chapter worth 25 points each. There are no retakes or tests dropped. If the student is absent the day of a test or quiz that student will take the test the next day.
- 2) HOMEWORK – There will be no homework in this class.
- 3) NOTEBOOK- All students are required to bring a 3-ring notebook filled with 8 ½ x 11 inch paper. Notebooks must have three sections in it (class notes, tests & quizzes, and handouts) with dividers. Neatness and organization counts. The notebook will be collected and graded every quarter for 50 points.
- 4) QUARTER GRADES- Your grade at the end of each quarter will be calculated based on the total points on each of your tests, quizzes and notebook.
- 5) SEMESTER GRADE- This is based on each quarter (40% each) and your midterm grade (20%).
- 6) FINAL GRADE- Each semester is worth 50% of your final grade.
- 7) TEACHER AVAILABILITY FOR EXTRA HELP- I will be available after school every day Monday thru Friday until 2:35. I can also see students during break in my room and in the library period 7.
- 8) ATTENDANCE POLICY- See student handbook (BOE Policy #5113).
- 9) CELL PHONES- Students are not allowed to have cell phones out during class. Any student caught using a cell phone will be required to leave it on my desk for the duration of the period.
