*Welcome. This is a list of requirements that you can refer to throughout the school year to make your high school math class a success.*

- 1) TESTS & QUIZZES - There will be a test given after each chapter worth a total of 100 points. There will be 2-3 quizzes given after each chapter worth 25 points each. There are no retakes or tests/quizzes dropped. If a student is absent the day of a test or quiz that student will take the test the next day.
- 2) HOMEWORK- There will be no homework in this class.
- 3) NOTEBOOK - All students are required to bring a 3-ring notebook filled with 8 ½ x 11 inch paper. Notebooks must have three sections in it (class notes, homework, and handouts/tests & quizzes) with dividers. Neatness and organization count! Your notebook will be graded after each quarter and is worth a total of 50 points.
- 4) TEXTBOOK – All students are expected to bring their notebook, textbook, calculator and pencil every day to class. Textbooks must be covered.
- 5) QUARTER GRADES- Your grade at the end of each quarter will be calculated based on the total points on each of your tests, quizzes, projects, homework & notebook grade.
- 6) SEMESTER GRADES- This is based on each quarter (40% each) and your midterm exam (20%). Your final grade is based on the same principle.
- 7) CALCULATORS- All students are strongly recommended to have a scientific calculator. If a student cannot afford a calculator the school will provide them with one.
- 8) TEACHER AVAILABILITY FOR EXTRA HELP- I will be available after school every day Monday thru Friday until 2:35. Also, I will be available every day during break and in the media center during period 7.
- 9) CELL PHONES- Students are not allowed to have cell phones out during class time. Any student caught using a cell phone will be required to leave it on the teacher's desk for the duration of the period.
- 10) ATTENDANCE POLICY- See student handbook (BOE Policy #5113).
