

Welcome. This is a list of requirements you can refer to throughout the school year.

- 1) TESTS & QUIZZES- There will be a mid-chapter quiz given within each chapter worth 25 points each. There will be a test given after each chapter worth a total of 100 points. There are no retakes or tests dropped. If a student is absent they will take the test the following day.
- 2) HOMEWORK- Homework will be assigned on a weekly basis. Homework will be collected and graded at the end of each week. This will be worth 10 points for each assignment. Late assignments will lose points.
- 3) NOTEBOOK - All students are required to bring a 3-ring notebook filled with 8 ½ x 11 inch paper and graph paper. Notebooks must have three sections in it (class notes, homework, and tests/quizzes) with dividers.
- 4) TEXTBOOK – All students are expected to bring a notebook, textbook, calculator pencil and eraser every day to class. All textbooks must be covered.
- 5) QUARTER GRADES- Your grade after each quarter will be calculated based on the total points of your tests, quizzes and homework grades.
- 6) SEMESTER & FINAL GRADES- Your semester grade is based on each quarter (40% each) and your midterm exam (20%). Your final grade is calculated by taking 50% of each semester grade.
- 7) CALCULATORS- All students are strongly recommended to have a TI-83, TI-84, TI-84-C or better graphic calculator. If a student cannot afford a graphing calculator, the school will provide them with one.
- 8) EXTRA HELP- I will be available after school every day Monday thru Friday until 2:35. Also, I will be available every day during break in my room and during period 7 in the library.
- 9) CELL PHONES- Students are not allowed to use cell phones during class. Any student caught using a cell phone will be required to leave it on the teacher's desk for the duration of the period.
- 10) ATTENDANCE POLICY- See student handbook (BOE Policy #5113).
- 11) ACADEMIC and SOCIAL/CIVIC EXPECTATIONS- Students will be able to analyze situations effectively. Students will also be able to demonstrate honesty, responsibility, respect, and safety.
