Course Expectations

In physical education classes, students work on a variety of academic expectations: analysis, communication, literacy and collaboration. Students also work on the social expectations: honesty, responsibility, respect, and safety. This year our classes will be focusing on collaboration using the school rubrics.

All physical education classes will be held every day for the entire semester.

Teacher Expectations/ Grading Policy:

- Student has proper physical education footwear (sneakers) and is prepared for the start of class
- Follows all teacher's instructions without hesitation - Always on task
- Takes a physically active part in all of the games and activities of the class
- Gives positive support to teammates or classmates all of the time
- Always uses skills taught and applies skills to game or performance

Students will be graded by unit activities. Each unit will last two weeks (8-10 classes) and will be graded on a 50-point scale.

Sport Offerings:

Flag Football, Softball, Backyard Games, Soccer/Speedball, Ultimate Frisbee, Fitness Activities, Tennis, and Lacrosse, Volleyball, Basketball, Bowling, Floor Hockey and Team Handball.

Behavior Expectations:

1st offense: Student receives a warning

2nd offense: Removal from activity and loss of credit for the day.

3rd offense: Removal from class, loss of daily credit, and detention.

For safety reasons, students may be removed from activity prior to receiving a warning from the teacher.



Physical Education Rules:

If a student is medically unable to participate in physical education class, they must receive a “medical excuse” note from the nurse prior to the start of class.

If you are unable to participate in a physical education class, you must remain with your class. If your class is playing on the soccer field, you must be on the soccer field with your class.

Since physical education classes meet for one semester, the credit withheld policy will take effect following a students’ 10th absence from class.



Students involved in after school athletics are required to take regular scheduled physical education class on practice and game days. **If a student does not participate in physical education class, that student cannot participate in his/her after school practice or game.**

Classes missed due to lack of proper physical education clothing (not being properly prepared) may be made up during the student’s study hall or after school. A pass must be obtained from your physical education teacher before you report to study hall. See your teacher for **limitations** on this program.

Headphones cannot be worn or used in class unless the teacher gives permission. No cell phones can be used in class, even if the student is not participating! Absolutely no photos can be taken in class without permission.
