- Guided Centers (including, but not limited to handwriting readiness, fine motor activities, art projects, and science exploration)
- Math (counting, shapes, numerals, measurement, comparing)
- Outside play or Motor group (both fine and gross motor activities)
- Dismissal

- A communication sheet will be emailed daily with each student. Preschool events are also included in the school-wide monthly newsletter.
