A statewide superintendent's phone conference was held with the state Commissioner of Education yesterday, March 19th and guidance was given as we are continuing to monitor COVID-19.

- Three items of importance provided by the Commissioner:
 - Connecticut public school districts will remain closed
 - While closed, we are to employ distance learning
 - The school year will end based on its present calendar ending date which is June 18th for our district

Districtwide Information

- Each schools administration will be in constant contact with their families and teachers
- Teachers will correspond with their students to provide updated instruction and information
- Principals have been in contact with families who need tech access and providing them with the procedure for obtaining a laptop
- Every student will have access to distance learning and supplemental hard copy lessons
- Your individual school will notify you when the school will be open for limited access
- Essential employees will be working unless, otherwise ordered by the Governor. Central Office Administration will also doing some work remotely, however, in order to keep the business part of the district running, there will be set hours for that to take place
- The buildings will be open Monday, 3-23 through Wednesday, 3/25 from 8:00 – 6:30 for pick-up of any student materials. We ask that all materials be picked up by the end of Wednesday
