

NORTH STONINGTON COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

All staff and students (or their parents/guardians) need to perform a self-assessment at home, prior to leaving for school, to identify fever and other possible COVID-19 symptoms. If they are experiencing any of the below listed symptoms, they are to stay home and contact the School Nurse to report the symptoms.

Key COVID-19 signs and symptoms from Addendum 5: Adapt, Advance Achieve: Interim Guidance for Responding to COVID-19 Scenarios in Connecticut Districts:

- Feeling Feverish (measured temp 100.4 degrees or more)
- Chills
- Uncontrolled NEW cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Difficulty Breathing
- Loss of taste or smell

Other protocols:

- All students/parents and staff will notify the School Nurse if they are sick with COVID-19 related symptoms, if they had a known contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 and have also had contact with the school population, or have had a positive COVID-19 test.
- Anyone with close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 must remain home for 14 days after exposure.
