

Wheeler: 296 families took survey

52% want a full return (154 families)

36.8% want to remain in the hybrid (109 families)

11.1% will continue to keep their child in a full distance model (33 families)*

*Wheeler currently has 45 students in the full distance model so some of our families did not respond to survey

If we go to a full return, that 11.1% jumps to 20.9% (60 families) which puts us at about 72 students moving or staying in full distance

NSES: 378 families took the survey

63.8% want a full return (241 families)

26.7% want to remain in the hybrid (101 families)

9.5% will continue to keep their child in a full distance model (36 families)*

*NSES currently has 51 students in the full distance model so some of our families did not respond to survey

If we go to a full return, that 9.5% jumps to 17.8.9% (66 families) which puts us at about 66 students moving or staying in full distance

NSPS Staff: 88 teachers took the survey

15.9% want a full return (14 teachers)

84.1% want to remain in the hybrid (74 teachers)
