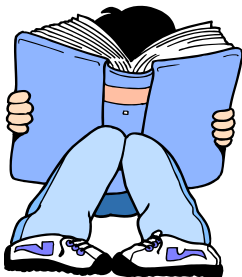
- 2 large glue sticks – 1 for fall/1 for spring
- pencils (**please** no mechanical kinds)
- **TWO soft** pencil cases (easier to fit in desk)
- hand pencil sharpener
- highlighters
- box of colored pencils
- one 1” binder with inside folder for Social Studies – white if possible
- one 1” binder with inside folder for Science – green if possible
- 5 two-pocket **plastic (if possible)** folders: 1 red for Spelling, 1 blue for Math, and 1 yellow for Writing, and 1 purple for Reading,
- 1 two-pocket folder for “Take Home/Bring Back to School folder” – free choice design!! 😊
- Bring your Andrew Clements book for the first day – which you have read completely.
